OUR PRINCIPLES & PURPOSE

We stand for freedom from occupation, and equal rights for all. International law guarantees these human rights, including the right to exist in peace and security.

We aim to end U.S. support for Israel's 43-year occupation of the Palestinian West Bank, Gaza and East Jerusalem, and to uphold equal rights for all.

OUR GOALS

We will inform, educate, and mobilize the public about the U.S. government's current role and potential role in the Israeli-Palestinian conflict.

Harmful U.S. policies include the provision of military aid to Israel -- \$3.075 billion in 2011 alone -- despite Israel's repeated violations of U.S. and international law.

We call for the U.S. to work within the U.N. to implement a just and lasting peace.

OUR CAMPAIGN

Our Campaign will build on existing opposition to settlements, land confiscation, house demolitions, and other violations of international law, by providing a common platform to challenge U.S. policies supporting the Israeli occupation of Palestine.

CHALLENGING U.S. POLICY



U.S. military and diplomatic support plays a crucial role in Israel's illegal occupation.

- Organizing to end military aid to Israel through our site www.aidtoisrael.org.
- Educating the public about policy developments through action alerts and analysis.
- Holding advocacy training & lobbying days.
- Building a Congressional District Coordinator (CDC) network.

BOYCOTT, DIVESTMENT & SANCTIONS

Boycott, divestment and sanctions (BDS) campaigns draw attention to the policies of companies that profit from Israeli apartheid.



We support BDS through:



- Organizing national campaigns against Caterpillar, Motorola, Ahava and TIAA-CREF for their complicity in Israel's human rights abuses.
- Providing organizing toolkits for hundreds of volunteers across the country.
- Conducting trainings for congregations, campuses and communities nationwide.
